Dr. P. Vasanthi, Chairman, BOS, extended a cordial welcome to all the members of Board of Studies. She briefed the members about the importance of redesigning the curriculum and syllabi of B.Tech. in Civil Engineering and also the importance of introducing Leadership and CEO training and Social Entrepreneurship as General Elective in the existing and new B.Tech curriculum. After the introductory remarks, the agenda items were taken up for discussion by the members of the Board of Studies.

ITEM 8.1

To consider and approve the curriculum and syllabi of B.Tech. in Civil Engineering, Regulations 2017

The following suggestions were put forth by the BOS members:

- In Civil Engineering Drawing, Infrastructure drawings to be included.
- A course on Design of Hydraulic structures can be offered instead of the course on Irrigation Engineering.
- In Transportation Engineering I, the syllabus may include only Highway Engineering
- Delhi Schedule of Rates along with CPWD specifications to be included in Estimation and costing
- Pre-read and post-read materials are needed for all the courses.
- MSW management and handling rules to be included in course on environmental engg
- Comparative analysis of Indian codes and other country codes can be included in the respective courses.
- Lean Construction can be offered as professional elective course.

After detailed discussions, it was resolved to approve the curriculum and syllabi of **B.Tech Civil Engineering** and recommend the same for approval by the Academic Council of the University. **This will come into effect from the academic year 2017 – 2018 onwards.**

ITEM 8.2

To consider and approve the curriculum of B.Tech. in Civil Engineering, Regulations 2013

The general elective courses CEO and Leadership training and Social Entrepreneurship are included in the B.Tech Civil Engineering Curriculum and syllabus, Regulations 2013 in the seventh semester and eighth semester respectively. After detailed deliberations it was resolved to approve the inclusion of the electives in the curriculum for the B.Tech Civil Engineering programme and recommend the same for approval by the Academic Council of the University

The curriculum is enclosed in *Annexure 8.2.1*.

ITEM 8.3

To consider and approve the Curriculum for M.Tech Structural Engineering, Regulations 2016

The number of credits of the course "Research Methodology for Engineers" to be increased from three to four so that it can be offered for Research Scholars. After detailed discussions, it was resolved to approve the curriculum for the M.Tech programme in Structural Engineering and recommend the same for approval by the Academic Council of the University. This will come into effect from the academic year 2017- 18 onwards.

The curriculum is enclosed in *Annexure 8.3.1*.

ITEM 8.4

To consider and approve the Curriculum for M.Tech Construction Engineering and Project Management, Regulations 2016

The number of credits of the course "Research Methodology for Engineers" to be increased from three to four so that it can be offered for Research Scholars After detailed discussions it was resolved to approve the curriculum for the M.Tech programme in Construction Engineering and Project Management and recommend the same for approval by the Academic Council of the University. This will come into effect from the academic year 2017-18 onwards.

To ratify the courses which were offered as electives in M.Tech. Structural Engineering for Ph.D. candidates.
